Additional Graduation Requirements

1. Be at least 18 years of age at the time of graduation or obtain high school release for early graduation.
2. Students who began high school after July 1, 2004 (graduating classes of 2008 and beyond), must complete a Culminating Project. If under age 21 at time of graduation from WCC, they must also pass the 10th grade WASL.
3. Students who graduate from WCC under age 21 who began high school prior to July 1, 2004 (graduating classes prior to 2008), will not be required to do a Culminating project or pass the 10th grade WASL, regardless of age at time of graduation.

**One high school credit equals 5 college credits. Previously earned high school credits may be applied to the requirements for this diploma.*
