SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION



The purpose of the Anna Rosemary Harris Memorial Study Abroad Scholarship is to provide a \$1,500 scholarship to help a Whatcom Community College student participate in one of WCC's study abroad programs.

Anna Rosemary Harris, 19, died April 2, 2013 in an accident while vacationing in Taiwan. Anna was homeschooled through elementary and middle school and then entered Sehome High, which she attended for two years. She then enrolled in Running Start full time at Whatcom Community College and graduated with honors with her Associate of Arts degree as well as her high school diploma in 2012. She then began at Western Washington University at junior status, with the goal of becoming a physical therapist.

In Taiwan Anna was living her dream of traveling and exploring other cultures. She had been planning to do an intensive Korean language program and thought about doing a physical therapy internship in that country.

This scholarship reflects one of Anna's passions: seeking to understand other cultures through travel.

Recipients of this award may use the funding to participate in whichever WCC study abroad program he or she chooses within the given award year. Scholarship applicants must:

- Complete WCC's 2015/2016 Study Abroad program application process
- Complete this scholarship application
- Demonstrate financial need
- Submit an essay as stated below
- This scholarship is open to all qualified applicants; however preference will be given to a woman who has never studied or traveled abroad.

**Awards are contingent upon acceptance into WCC's Study Abroad program.*
