

WCC/BTC and Windward High School RUNNING START TRANSFER GUIDE & FTE CHART

All classes must be 100 level or higher to be eligible for credit through the Running Start Program. Any class numbered below 100 must be paid for by the student and will not earn high school credit without prior written approval from the high school principal.

Credit Equivalency Each class taken at Whatcom Community College (WCC) and Bellingham Technical College (BTC) will be transcribed based on the following equivalency chart.

<u>WCC/BTC</u>	<u>WHS</u>	<u>WCC/BTC</u>	<u>WHS</u>
1.0 credits	= .20 credits	4.0 credits	= .80 credits
2.0 credits	= .40 credits	5.0 credits	= 1.0 credits

Fine Art	Any course from Art, Drama, Music, Film, or Dance 101, 102.
PE	Any activity-based PE. 1 Dance class may be counted as PE credit.
Health	PE 181 (Health & Wellness)
Elective	Any class 100 level or higher

FULL TIME EQUIVALENCY

Washington State pays for Running Start students to attend a community college up to a Full Time Equivalent (FTE) of 1.2. The following chart shows how many classes you can enroll in at Windward PLUS Running Start:
