

# *Welcome to Running Start and Fall 2017 Registration!*



To register for classes, please follow these steps:

- 1. Complete your Enrollment Verification Form** (enclosed) with your high school Running Start contact (see enclosed list) as soon as possible (including homeschool students).
- 2. Complete your Advising Preparation Checklist** on the back of this paper.
- 3. Look up your Registration Access Time online**, available after June 1.
  - Start at [whatcom.edu](http://whatcom.edu); Hover over I WANT TO..., then click on "Register for Classes".
  - Click on the "registration access time" link.
  - **Enter your WCC Student ID number. Your SID will be emailed to you.**
  - **Enter your PIN (birthdate: mmddyy)**
  - Select 2017-18 and 2- Fall; Click on "Get My Registration Access Time"
- 4. Come to drop-in advising in the Running Start office (LDC 134)** to finalize your class schedule, on or after your Registration Access Time, through June 16, Monday-Friday 9am-4:30pm. No appointment necessary.
  - Do NOT miss high school classes to come to WCC.
  - Bring your completed Enrollment Verification Form, Advising Preparation Checklist, and photo ID.
  - After June 16, advising will be by appointment. Please call the Running Start office to schedule.

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***Ready now? Start early and avoid the lines!***  
***Make an early Advising Appointment before May 19***  
***by calling the Running Start office at 383-3123.***  
***Bring your completed Enrollment Verification Form.***

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If you need help at any stage, just call the Running Start office at 360-383-3123.

*Bring this completed checklist with you to your advising appointment!*

- Decide how many classes you will be taking at the high school, if any.
- Use the Enrollment Verification Form from your high school counselor to see how many credits you're allowed at WCC.
- Use the Enrollment Verification Form to determine which classes you need for high school graduation.
- Use your high school's Equivalency Guide to determine which college classes meet your high school requirements. <http://whatcom.ctc.edu/get-started/running-start/current-students>. (Get Started -> Running Start -> Current Students). Scroll down and click on your high school or district.
- Decide what times and days you are available to be at WCC. Consider high school classes, activities, work, family commitments, and transportation time.
- Consider which classes you need for your degree or other future goals. (Don't know? That's okay. That's what your advisor is for!)
- Decide which classes you're interested in taking at WCC this quarter. Use Class Search (on the bar at the top of the website or [www.whatcom.edu/schedulesearch](http://www.whatcom.edu/schedulesearch)) to find classes, days, and times. When searching, be sure to choose the appropriate quarter. Click on Details to find out if there are any prerequisites. Make a wish list!
