

# Veterans, Military, and Eligible Dependent Application for Residency and Non-Resident Waiver

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**SECTION I – Veteran/Military/Eligible Dependent Residency:** You might qualify as a Washington resident if you meet one of the following conditions:

- You are a member/dependent of the U.S. military stationed in Washington or a member of the Washington national guard. **(Attach DD-214, NOBE, or orders indicating WA as duty station)**
  - You are a Veteran who has honorably separated from the uniformed services after at least ninety days of active duty service, are eligible for federal benefits authorizing educational assistance benefits for veterans, and enters into an institution of higher education in Washington within three years of the date of separation. **(Attach your Post 9/11 or Montgomery GI Bill Certificate of Eligibility and DD-214)**
  - You are a student who is entitled to Veterans Administration education assistance benefits based on the student's relationship as a spouse, former spouse, or child to an individual who has separated from the uniformed service with any period of honorable service after at least ninety days of active duty service, and who enters an institution of higher education in Washington within three years of the service member's date of separation. **(Attach your Veterans Administration Certificate of Eligibility and service member's DD-214)**
  - You are a student who is entitled to Veterans Administration educational assistance benefits based on the student's relationship with a deceased member of the uniformed services who completed at least ninety days of active duty service and died in the line of duty. **(Attach your Veterans Administration Certificate of Eligibility and service member's DD-1300)**
  - You are a student who is entitled to Veterans Administration educational assistance under the Post 9/11 GI Bill program based on the student's relationship as a spouse, former spouse, or child to an individual who is currently serving in the U.S. Armed Forces. **(Attach you Veterans Administration Post 9/11 Certificate of Eligibility)**
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**SECTION II – Veteran Non-Resident Waiver:** If you do not meet veteran/military residency requirements of the State of Washington as outline above, you may be eligible for a waiver of the non-resident tuition, which would substantially reduce the amount of tuition you pay.

- You are a veteran of the U.S. Military. **(Attach a copy of your DD214)**
