



Install VMWare for Windows (Student)


1. Open an internet browser window



2. Go to vdi.whatcom.edu




3. Click on "Go to Downloads" in the VMware Horizon Client for Windows section.




4. Click "Download Now"


5. Double-click the “VMware Horizon.exe” file in your Downloads folder.

7. At the Success window, click Finish




8. Click Restart Now



9. Open VMware by double-click the VMware Horizon icon.




10. Click **Add Server** and enter: **vdi.whatcom.edu**
