PRESIDENT'S REPORT/ CORRESPONDENCE

- ♦ Whatcom Community College has been notified by the Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities (NWCCU) that the college is scheduled to submit a Year One Self-Evaluation Report based on the new NWCCU Accreditation Standards in Spring 2012. An off-site evaluation will be conducted on these materials by a peer group that will prepare a report of findings which will be considered by the Commission Board in July, 2012.
- President Kathi's postal correspondence included two letters from an inmate at Folsom Penitentiary in California containing political rhetoric.
- ◆ President Kathi shared highlights from the October WACTC meeting. Vice President Ray White assisted her in presenting a PowerPoint containing graphs of system-wide trends
